



4.4. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

The events will be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU), except when specifically amended with the WU 2017 Regulations.

The programme includes the following events:

- Men
- Ladies
- Pairs
- Ice dance

Each country may enter:

Men	three (3) skaters		
Ladies	three (3) skaters		
Pairs	three (3) couples		
Ice Dance	three (3) couples		

Each skater will be authorised to take part in FISU events only after the applying skater has submitted satisfactory documentation and received from the Secretariat an ISU Clearance Certificate (ISU Rule 109).

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors. Only accredited athletes can be considered for the draw of a starting list.

4.4.1. ATHLETE'S SELECTION

Where the number of quantitative entries in Men, Ladies, Pairs and Ice Dance is larger than the authorised number of skaters, the following selection criteria will be applied:



- One or more selection rounds will be made until the maximum number of authorised entries is reached (as described in the table above);
- During each selection round a maximum of one (1) athlete or couple in each category from each country will be selected, except for the 1st round where two (2) athletes or couples may be selected for the host country and countries with medallists at the last Winter Universiade.
- The selection criteria within each round are the following:
 - 1. Host country;
 - 2. NUSF participating in the previous WU figure skating competitions based on the higher ranking in the final results of the last WU (from top to bottom);
 - 3. NUSF who did not participate in the last WU will be selected by a wild card system according to the criteria defined by the FISU CTI-UH (geographical and continental representation, participation in previous WU).
- A reserve list will be made with the number of athletes that have not been selected for each country.

Three (3) months before the opening ceremony of the WU the OC, upon FISU approval, will inform all participating countries about the number of athletes selected for each country and the ones on the reserve list. The final composition of the judges' panel will be defined based on the list of selected athletes (cf. art.12.5.6).

If an NUSF wants to enter less athletes after the selection is complete, the NUSF has to inform the OC. However, in the event of unused entry quota from NUSF and athletes' withdrawal, the financial dues for the ITOs (cf. art. 11.10.2) must still be paid by the NUSF to the OC during the accreditation process upon arrival to the Winter Universiade. If any, the NUSF on the reserve list will be contacted in order to take the vacant place.

4.4.2. PROTEST AND APPEAL

Any protest of a sport or disciplinary nature must reach the Jury or other competent authority according to the regulations laid down by the appropriate ISF. Such protest must be accompanied by a deposit, the amount of which is set in line with the ISU General Regulations Rule 123, if not otherwise specified in the technical regulations of concerned sport.

Any sport disciplinary situation, which cannot be satisfactorily resolved by the sport technical committees and the sport specific disciplinary regulations, will be reported to the FISU Disciplinary Committee for further action to be taken. Where appropriate, a report will be sent to the ISF concerned Committee.

Each Head of Delegation or his/her deputies are authorized to lodge an appeal against the decision of the Jury. This appeal must be submitted in writing to the Jury of Appeal or competent authority in accordance with the regulation of the appropriate ISF.



4.5. COMPETITION FORMAT 4.5.1. MEN SHORT PROGRAM

- The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rule Single and Pair Skating 2016, Rule 611, para 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

4.5.2. MEN FREE SKATING

- In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2016, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.
- Duration: 4 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

4.5.3. LADIES SHORT PROGRAM

- The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2016, Rule 611, para 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

4.5.4. LADIES FREE SKATING

- In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2016, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.
- Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

4.5.5. PAIRS SHORT PROGRAM

- The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2016, Rule 620, para 1 and 2, group for 2016/17 and the respective ISU Communication.
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

4.5.6. PAIRS FREE SKATING

- In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2016, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.
- Duration: 4 min. and 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

4.5.7. ICE DANCE SHORT DANCE

- In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2016, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 1998, 2003 and subsequent updates.
- Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec



4.5.8. ICE DANCE FREE DANCE

- In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2016, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 1998, 2003 and subsequent updates.
- Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

4.6. MUSIC INFORMATION/PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET 4.6.1. MUSIC INFORMATION

A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs, for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be listed for each Competitor on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not submitted, practice will not be provided.

4.6.2. PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

The Program Content Sheet must be submitted to the Competition Manager and the ISU Technical Delegate before December 29, 2016. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the terminology for the indicating planned elements for each Segment.

4.7. COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION MUSIC

Information concerning competition and exhibition music may be found in ISU Announcement: Communication 2034 and Music Rules 343.

4.7.1. COLLECTION/RETURN OF COMPETITION MUSIC

According to Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, Rule 343:

- 1. All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD or in any other approved format.
- a) The music covers/discs must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by the Competitor and by the coach, when submitted at the time of registration;
- b) Each program (Short Program/Free Skating/Pattern Dance when music is provided by the Couple/Short Dance/Free Dance) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc;
- c) Competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.
- 2. All music used for competitive events must be played on high quality electronic recorders, e.g. MP3 Player or similar, computer or CD Player, one or two of which shall be used during the competition. The organizer shall furnish, for each rink used for the competition and practice, adequate facilities for the reproduction and playback of music. The facilities to be provided by the



organizer must be set forth in the Announcement of the Competition.

- 3. Precaution must be taken to prevent frequency and/or voltage variations.
- 4. The volume level of the music as determined by the Medical Commission in either the practice or competition rinks must not exceed 85-90-dB Sound Pressure Level in any part of the arena.


Almaty Arena will consist of: an ice arena with 12,000 seats, a training rink with a recreation complex, and a swimming pool. The layout of the ice arena will function as a universal platform for figure skating, curling, ice hockey, boxing, basketball, volleyball, as well as a concert hall with 5,000 seats.

The FoP consists of a regular 60 metres x 30 metres ice rink. Almaty Arena is in a walking distance from the AV entrance (200 m).

Ice Rink «Hockey World» has 288 seating places, VIP room, café, storage rooms and small mall. The area has football field 25x15m and 50 places parking zone.



General layout (Almaty Arena)



Doping control will be carried out in accordance with the rules and regulations of FISU.

4.12.2. LIST OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

The actual list of prohibited substances and treatment is defined in accordance with WADA international standards. National University Sports Federations will be responsible for ensuring that their delegations, namely athletes, are made aware of this prohibited list. Ignorance of the prohibited list will in no way



constitute a valid excuse for any participant of the WU violating valid antidoping rules. For the WADA list of prohibited sub-stances, please refer to the following website: www.wada-ama.org.

4.12.3. TESTING

In accordance with the preliminary Test Distribution Plan elaborated by the FISU CMI, the required number of urine and blood tests will be collected both during and out of competition. Athletes may be tested at any time during the period of their accreditation.

Urine and blood tests in and outside competition will be performed by the doping control officers licensed by Kazakhstan Anti-Doping Agency under the supervision of the FISU CMI.

All test results will be sent to the confidential email address of Chairman of the FISU International Medical Committee (CMI) as well put into ADAMS.

The FISU CMI will bear the responsibility for the result management in the case of a violation of the Anti-doping rules.

4.12.4. DOPING CONTROL STATIONS

Athletes must have their accreditation badges with them at all times in the Doping Control Stations.

Doping Control Station for Figure Skating athletes will be allocated at the Almaty Arena: Figure Skating Arena 1st floor (Block A) (please refer to Appendix 7.2).

4.12.5. THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION (TUE)

Athletes taking part in the Winter Universiade requiring a Therapeutic Use Exemption must apply to the appropriate Anti-doping Organisation as soon as possible. International Standards for Therapeutic Use Exemption will be applied. Should prohibited substances or methods be used after the opening of the WU, applications for emergency TUE should be made to the TUE Committee of FISU.

4.12.6. EMERGENCY TREATMENT

In the case of an emergency, if an athlete has to use prohibited substances or methods during the Winter Universiade, team doctors will be responsible for completing the TUE form and without any delay submit it to the FISU CMI.

The Medal-Awarding Ceremonies will take place at the end of the Figure Skating competitions accordingly to the following schedule (time based on estimated finish time of the competition):

The OC will inform the Head of delegation, the team officials and the athletes about the time, location and procedure. In case of a no show of a medalist, the medals and mascots maybe delivered to an official of the relevant delegation. The official must wear the uniform of the delegation to take part in the ceremony. S/he must not mount the podium but walk in front of it and take the medal and mascot in his/her hands. All flags will be raised. During the Medal-Awarding Ceremony:

- The athletes are not allowed to bring national flags or any other items on the podium and are expected to take their caps off.
- The athletes must wear their delegation's approved uniform or the uniform with which they competed if the ceremony takes place right after the end of the competition and at the same venue.
- During the playing of the FISU anthem and the raising of the flags, they shall face the flags and conduct themselves in a dignified manner all the times. No national anthem is played during the ceremony.
- The detailed rules of this procedure will be in accordance with the rules of FISU.

4.13.2. DIPLOMA OF HONOURS:

- The athletes ranked one (1) to eight (8) will receive a Diploma of Honours.
- For team events, each team member will receive a personal diploma of honour mentioning his/her name and the team ranking.
- Diplomas of participation and of honour are not distributed to winners at the Medal-Awarding ceremony. They are handed to the Head of Delegation or an appointed representative of each delegation in the Athletes' Village at a later time.

4.14. PRESS INTERVIEWS

Sub-press Centres are set up in the main/finals competition venues to facilitate interviews and reports by the accredited media. After the competitions, all



athletes must exit the Field of Play through the Mixed Zone, and brief interviews are conducted in the Mixed Zone. Coaches and winning athletes/teams take part in press conferences after the Awarding Ceremonies on request of the press manager. During the press conference, interpretation will be provided in the official language (English) and RUS/KAZ languages. If one does not speak the official language, such person should bring his/her own interpreter of the language to the press conferences.

5. SERVICE INFORMATION

5.1. ACCREDITATION

Location of the Main Accreditation Centre: Almaty, Alatau district, Momyshuly avenue, Northern Ryskulova street. At the Athletes' Village (Refer to AV Map) **Important:** No athlete will be allowed to attend official training or competition without the Accreditation Card. Temporary cards do not allow athletes to take part to official trainings and competitions.

5.2. TRANSPORTATION

5.2.1. GENERAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

The OC guarantees the transportation of every one that is accredited. The Transportation Committee has established the necessary organization to plan the transportation needs of WU from the day of the opening of the AV (24 January).

5.2.2. COMPETITION AND TRAINING TRANSPORTATION

The competition venue Almaty arena is at walking distance from the Athletes' Village and therefore no transportation will be needed. Transportation will be organized for athletes to reach the training venue - Ice rink Hockey World.

5.3. MEDICAL SERVICES 5.3.1. GENERAL OVERVIEW

The OC provides accredited persons with free and adequate medical care. This medical care includes all appropriate emergency care, diagnosis and treatment of all injuries and illnesses directly and indirectly related to the WU, and this obligation will begin from the day of the opening of the AV until two (2) days following the closing ceremony. This will not cover medical care while in country if the credential person has already officially left the AV or officially left the host country.

All WU participants must have own medical insurance. Only emergency medical care for WU accredited participants will be covered by the OC.





7.2.1. 1ST FLOOR (ALMATY ARENA)






7.2.2. 2ND FLOOR (ALMATY ARENA)






7.2.3. 3RD FLOOR (ALMATY ARENA)






7.2.4. 1ST FLOOR (Ice Rink «Hockey World»)






7.2.5. 2ND FLOOR (Ice Rink «Hockey World»)


